

Florida education:

 - Found on Bright Futures website – left column "Comprehensive Course Table"
 - Search by course name or subject area
 - For any course, you can use the chart to determine whether the course counts toward Bright Futures (FAS/FMS column) or Florida state university system (SUS column) admissions requirements. C – counts, N – does not
